DWI Assessments:

If you have been convicted of a DWI (Driving While Impaired), you must undergo a substance use assessment in order to get your driver's license re-instated. You must also complete either an education program or treatment program, whichever is recommended as a result of the assessment. If you fail to submit to a breath test, or if you registered over 0.14%, you will be required to complete a treatment program.

All assessments must be conducted by an authorized DWI provider. Your assessment will be completed by a Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialist, who is licensed by the North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Practice Board. In order to be assessed, you are required to bring your court papers to the assessment. The assessor must also have a copy of your "Complete Driving History" from the DMV.

Assessments follow the American Society of Addiction Medicine criteria to determine your needs. If you are not given a substance use disorder diagnosis, you will be referred to an education program.

The cost of NC DWI Assessments is \$100. The \$100 fee is established by the Legislature of the State of NC. No agency in the state of NC is allowed by law to charge more or less than the \$100 fee. The full fee is to be collected at the time of the assessment.

All persons in need of receiving a substance abuse assessment and substance abuse education or treatment have the right to choose their service provider.
